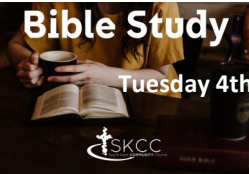

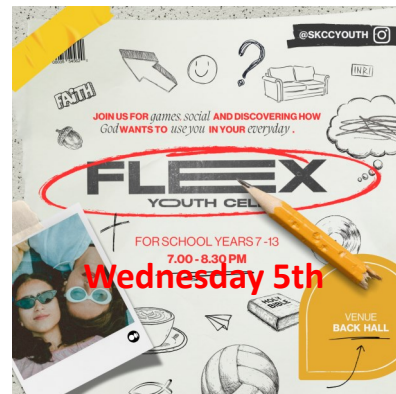

*That said, if you decide to come last minute, you're still warmly welcome!*

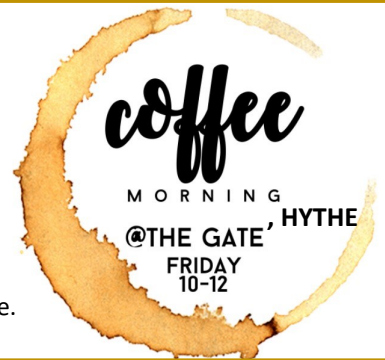
**Sunday Morning Gathering 10.30 a.m.**
