You might litter pick, give out some flowers, pay for someone's ice-cream, return a trolley for someone at Morrisons, send a text to someone to say you're thinking of them, open a door for someone at the shops, some other acts of kindness that only you could think of.

Or maybe you will try 'treasure hunting' - asking God to place someone on your heart who He wants to connect with and just say "I know this might be really weird but is there anything I can pray for you?".

For those unable to go out, your key role is to cover this time in prayer, led by Sue Oliver at The Cornerstone Centre.
