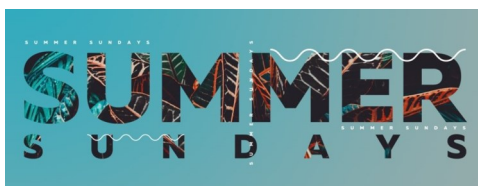


SKCC news for week beginning 4th August
